EARLY INTERVENTION WHAT THE RESEARCH SAYS

Decades of quality research highlights how early childhood experiences play a critical role in brain development. The first three years of a child's life are particularly important. Positive early experiences are essential prerequisites for later success in school, the workplace and the community.

Services to young children who have, or are at risk for, developmental delays have been shown to positively impact outcomes across developmental domains. High quality early intervention services can change a child's developmental trajectory and improve outcomes for children, whānau and communities. Intervention is likely to be more effective and less costly when it is provided earlier in life, rather than later.

Families benefit from early intervention by being better able to meet their children's special needs from an early age, and throughout their lives. Benefits to society

include a reduced economic burden through a decreased need for special education and other

support, and happier, more resilient families who contribute to their communities.
